New AR and DA Pam 623-3

Effective 1 Apr 14, the revised AR and DA Pam 623-3, dated 31 Mar 14 was implemented. Please review the new regulations and monitor the S-1 Net. There are an abundance of changes and helpful information.

Rating Schemes

Effective 1 Apr 14, all rating schemes of two-star level command or below must be approved by the next higher commander. All rating scheme changes will be submitted to Mr. Hutta, NLT the 5th of each month. The DCSHR/G1 authentication schedule to MEDCOM is June, Sep, Dec, and Mar (end of each quarter).

MEDCOM Memo – Exception to Policy for Rater Date of Rank Requirements

Effective 1 Apr 14, approval was granted by HQDA to allow AMEDD Colonels (COLs) in the following positions: Deputy Commander's, COL-level Directors, and the Director, AFME regardless of the component in the U.S. Armed Forces to serve as raters or as senior raters for those COLs under their supervision who are senior to them by date of rank.
